15 percent of global greenhouse gas emissions, massive demands made on land and water, antibiotic resistance: Industrial livestock farming has become a global problem. That's why more and more scientists and entrepreneurs are looking for alternatives to regular meat production. One of them is Joshua Tetrick. In California, he's working on a way to grow meat in a bioreactor. In huge tanks, he multiplies the muscle cells of chickens and cultivates them with plant-based nutrients. The resulting pulp is molded into fibrous meat with the help of a plant scaffold. The documentary **Fake Steak – The Taste of Future Food** explores some of the alternatives to factory farming.



Reforming Aquaculture

Around 50 percent of global farmed salmon production takes place in Norwegian waters. Chile is in second place with 25 percent. With global demand for salmon still rising, worldwide production is expanding. But there is also a downside to the industry: Concerns about disease and die-offs in farmed stocks, the use of antibiotics and the threat to wild salmon stocks posed by aquaculture. Is it possible to expand salmon production while improving standards and conditions? The largest salmon farm in the world, in Norway, is investing heavily in an attempt to do just that. Transforming Business wants to know how state supervision and animal

welfare standards can be improved.
